

SCIENCE

This term we will focus on magnets and springs. We will learn about healthy living, including looking at how the right nutrition helps us to grow.

PSHE

During the first half term our focus will be on making and keeping friends and during the second half term we will be exploring the ways in which we can keep ourselves safe.

MUSIC

The children will be working on their singing skills this term and improving their playing of musical instruments. They will also be exploring arrangements and pentatonic scales using Music Express.

ICT

This term we will be exploring simulations and learning how the computer can help you to manipulate sound.

RE

As part of Hampshire's curriculum for schools we will be exploring the life and teachings of Jesus and investigating what Christians believe about Easter. We will also be focusing on the role churches play in religions.

GEOGRAPHY

This term we will be undertaking a geographical study of Hartley Wintney in which we will be exploring settlement types, investigating land use in the village, looking at the services provided in the village and conducting a range of traffic surveys. Weather permitting we hope to walk into the village to carry out our work.

PE

In gymnastics we will be working individually, in pairs and in small groups; learning to control our bodies to jump and land safely on and off the low apparatus. We will also be investigating ways of balancing on different body parts. In games we will be working at passing and catching a large ball.

HISTORY

In history we learn about the Romans and the impact of the Roman invasion on Britain.

DT

Our focus for this term is healthy eating and we will be evaluating and creating a range of healthy salads. We will also have the Warburtons sandwich team visiting us and helping us design and make a healthy sandwich.

ART

This term we will experiment with lines and textures and create our own examples of Aboriginal Art.
