

## SCIENCE

In the first half term, the children will be looking at light and how we see things. The second half term will involve adaptation, and will be exploring the idea of evolution and inheritance.

## PSHE

This term the emphasis will be based around the world of work and money; we will look at different jobs and the processes involved in applying for jobs including personal statements.

## ICT

In the first half of the term the children will be evaluating presentation software, comparing the use of PowerPoint to Prezi, and the advantages and disadvantages of each. In the second half of term, the children will be manipulating sound using audacity.

## FRENCH

The children will be continuing their oral skills with the fourth year of French teaching. The emphasis will be on songs, stories and conversation. The topics covered will include, weather, classroom objects and telling the time.

# Year 6 Spring

## PE

In the first half of the term we will be focusing on creative dance compiling group 'street dances' and outside games will be tag rugby (with SCL). During the second half of the term, we will be concentrating on orienteering and problem solving skills outside (with SCL) and gymnastics indoors.

## GEOGRAPHY

We will be concentrating on Geography throughout this term. Our topic focuses on the Rainforest. As well as covering a range of aspects linked to this, we also use the topic to develop map skills, the theme of sustainability and tourism.

## ART

In art, children will be exploring the works of Henri Rousseau, analysing his style and content of his works. They will use their research, linked to our rainforest topic, to explore texture and colour when painting their own rainforest scene.

## RE

Based on Hampshire's curriculum for schools, 'Living Difference', we will be studying the theme of Remembering and Freedom. This will covers aspects of Judaism and the Christian festival of Easter.
